

Edmonston Road Rain Garden

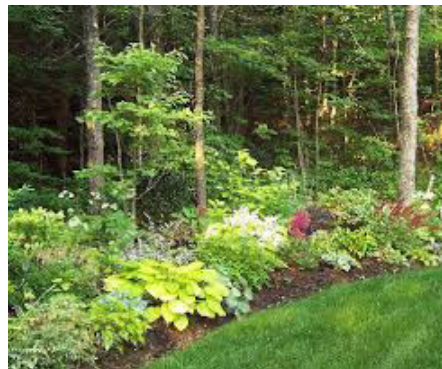

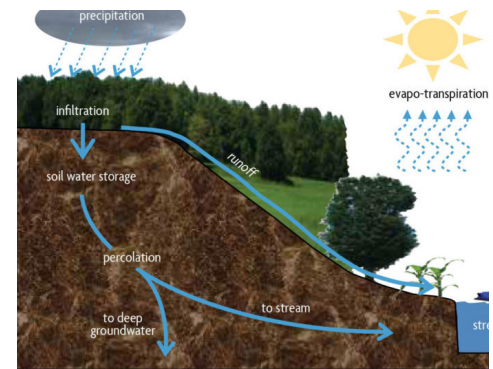

UMD/School of Landscape Architecture provides an environmentally sensitive gateway for the community. An aesthetic appeal environmental education by the use of:

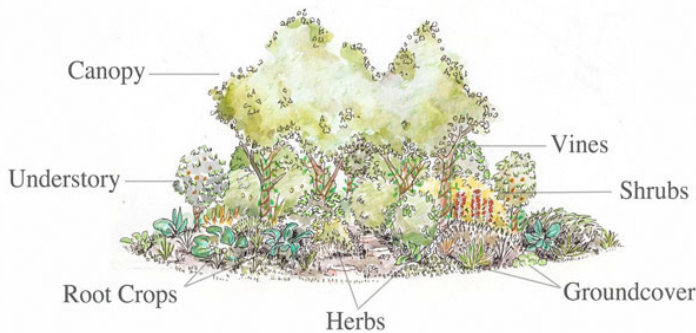
- a forest edge garden

- permeable paving and lighting



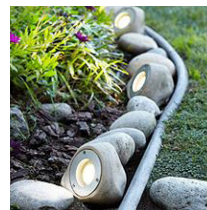
Forest edge garden example
